He is Director of the Innovation Center for Biomedical Informatics and also serves as Co-Director of the MedStar-Georgetown Collaborative Center for Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare Research and Education AI Colab. For much of his career he has helped manage different biological and Bbomedical data repositories and related resources. Most significantly the Universal Protein Resource (UniProt.org) an internationally funded and managed resource for the functional annotation of all Protein Sequences. He believes in the mission of collecting and preserving scientific data for now and the future which is part of CoreTrustSeal's mission.
